## Art of the State Ceremony and Tours Presented Virtually for 2020

*Art of the State*, the annual juried art exhibition presented by The State Museum of Pennsylvania in association with the Pennsylvania Heritage Foundation, was featured online this year because the museum has been closed during the COVID-19 pandemic. Prizes for the 53rd event were awarded at a virtual ceremony broadcast via social media on September 13, 2020.

Winners were chosen from 108 works selected from 1,901 entries in five categories: painting, photography, sculpture, craft and work on paper. The William D. Davis Memorial Award for Drawing was also selected, and the Art Docents Corps of The State Museum presented its Docents' Choice Award.

## PHF Cosponsors Virtual Archaeology Workshops

In October, Archaeology Month, The State Museum of Pennsylvania's Section of Archaeology presented a virtual Archaeology Workshops series on Zoom. Cosponsored by the Pennsylvania Heritage Foundation, the weekly series focused on the Delaware Indians in the past and present.

The four presentations featured were "The Prehistoric Archaeology of the Upper Delaware" by Roger Moeller, Archaeological Services; "The Contact Period in New Jersey: An Archaeological Perspective" by Gregory D. Lattanzi, New Jersey State Museum; "Lenapes and Colonists in the Lower Delaware Valley, 1624-1700" by Jean R. Soderlund, Lehigh University; and "The Delaware Indians: Where They Are Now?" by Brice Obermeyer, Delaware Historic Preservation.
